

Newtown and St Leonards Police team

- Officers have been carrying foot patrol within Belmont Park over the past months. There have been a few reports of anti-social behaviour in the park that has been dealt with by officers at the time. We are still liaising with Exeter City Council regarding the park being covered by a DPPO. The government are reviewing and making changes to the legislation regarding this designation and Exeter City Council are waiting for this to be implemented.
- There have been a number of reports regarding student transient noise through Newtown, mainly overnight. We are working closely with the University to find ways to deal with this. Where we have a link to an address a visit will be made by Police and University liaison officer. We have called at addresses whilst on patrol in the area where noise is heard that could be causing anti-social behaviour and advising the residents within to take the time to think about the effect on the wider community.
- Where there are issues within the community regarding student noise this needs to be reported to the University Estate Patrol at the time calling: - 01392 723999.
- We have also been carrying out foot patrol in the area of the toilets on Blackboy Road, as we have been getting reports of anti-social behaviour from numerous drinkers etc. Officers have attended taking personal details of people present and asking them to leave the area.
- We are not aware of any complaints that can be linked directly to the Newtown Community Hut. Maybe local residents could be asked as to what they feel is a sensible time to ask users to finish.
